Call for Papers

ELMAR-2018 symposium will be held in a beautiful town of Zadar on the Croatian Adriatic Sea. Only 3 km away from the conference hotel lies the "open-air museum" - town of Zadar, where the 3.000 year old history of the city can be found in every stone. Just take a stroll through the narrow alleys and discover the many hidden angles of the city. Even Alfred Hitchcock was enthusiastic about it: apparently he said that sunsets are better here than in California.

During the 60 years of activity ELMAR symposium became a significant scientific conference in the field of multimedia communications, image and video processing, navigation systems, speech and audio processing, telecommunications, wireless communications, electronics in marine, naval architecture, sea ecology, and other advanced research areas. Every year ELMAR symposium gathers specialists of various kinds (government representatives, navy, industry, universities and various business people from the region) to discuss the most recent issues and contribute to appropriate market development.

The scientific program includes keynote talks by eminent international experts and contributed papers. Papers accepted by two independent reviewers will be published in symposium proceedings available at the symposium and submitted for posting to the IEEE Xplore database.

Authors should prepare their papers according to ELMAR-2018 paper sample available at www.elmar-zadar.org, convert them to PDF based on IEEE requirements, and submit papers using a web-based submission system by **April 2, 2018**. Best student paper award will be given for authors who are still MSc or PhD students.
